Around 95 % questionnaires were received. The finding shows that most of users have acknowledged the reading. The study highlighted that reading habits have direct effect on academic performance of a student. The suggestion was given that handouts of lectures should be given to students as it forced them to read the books. The faculty should encourage students to read.

Alley Erdum (2019) In this study reading habit pattern of students studying in the Ankara University Department of primary education and Erchives university history dept were conducted. The study reveals that the questionnaire were distributed to 326 students and the results were found that university students reads novels, newspapers, magazines in leisure time and enjoy reading the literary works . they enjoy it as due to busy social life , for preparation of examinations, entertainment, humor and to satisfy their psychological needs.

- Non-print materials in the Tagore library are not so good enough.
- Catalogues of the library are not updated and digital library is also not so satisfactory.
- Most of the requested books are not enough copies so, the books and journals which we need or which we want to consult are not available because they are already issued.
- The resources like science journals are very old, most of them are very old publication and available very few.
- The resources of information available do not hold importance in present time as they are very old.

Suggestions Given By The Students On The Library of Lucknow University To Fulfill The Expectation of The Post Gratuate Students of The Pure Sciences?

The students have suggested the following suggestions:

- To bring more authentic books regarding P.G. students of particular to pure science subjects.
- Requirement of good internet network facility for the students to make them up-to-date in their subject without wasting time.
- Availability of science journals should be easy and more reading materials for the science students.
- Tagore library of Lucknow University should be accessible to students on web at their space.
- Xerox machine should available for the students to save their time and energy.
- 6. Catalogues should be updated of the tagore library.
- 7. Cleanliness is important in the library.
- 8. Digital library should be more enhanced.
- Students of pure science should be provided by more updated journals by the library.
- The resources of the Tagore library should be available online beside they are offline.
- The student of pure science should have all the journals and periodicals of good quality at their demand.

More of the international journals and the periodicals should be available for wide scope.

- Students of pure science should have separate space available in the Tagore library.
- Most of the days the server of the tagore library is down so there should be good networking.
- More and more science periodicals and resources should available.

- More specialized reading materials of pure science should available.
- The Tagore library should be enriched with more and more international papers and journals.
